

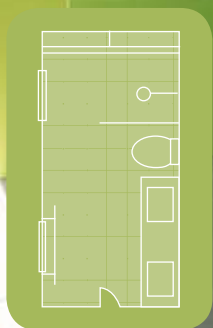

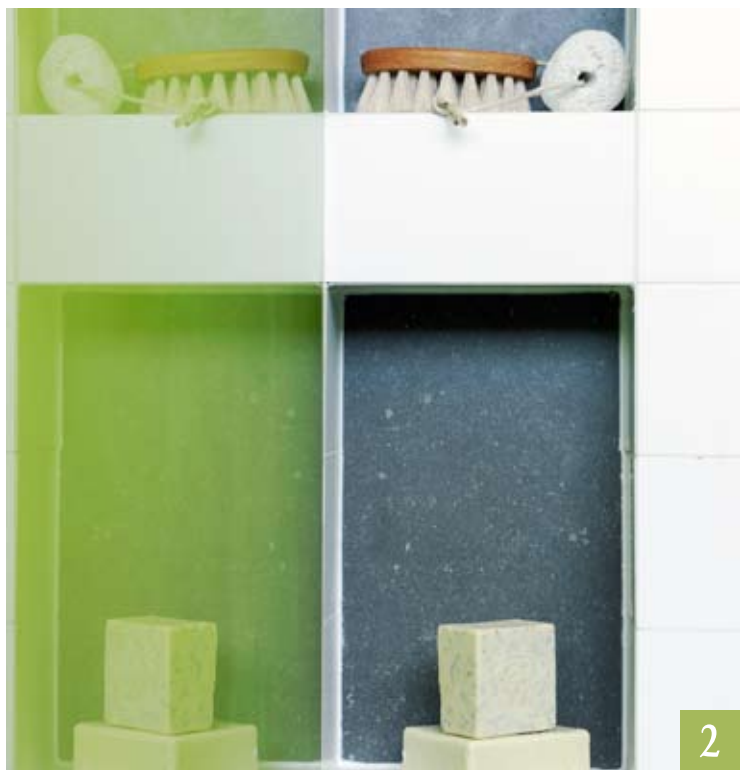
STREAMLINED STYLE AND A SPLASH OF LIME MAKE A BOLD STATEMENT OUT OF THIS REFRESHING SPACE

Design tip

When choosing your colour scheme, pick three shades that will do the work for you: a statement bright, a calming neutral and a darker hue to anchor the look





1+2 Time for lime

The shower's floor-to-ceiling glass splashback in vivid green lifts the entire space and gives a modern edge to the otherwise classic scheme. Colour-backed glass splashbacks are a brilliant way to introduce intensity without blowing the budget and you can choose the exact colour you want from hundreds of paint shades; they also present an easy-clean alternative to tiles and grout. A series of recesses, lined in the same charcoal-grey tiling used for the floor, offers a convenient place to store shower necessities.

3 Surface value

There is more to the pair of mirrors above the twin sinks and vanity than meets the eye. They reflect light from the windows positioned high on the opposite wall, and, teamed with dark timber veneer, they conceal cabinets recessed into the wall. This reduces their impact on what is a fairly narrow space, while still delivering deceptively deep storage. A tiled shelf, below, provides additional room for bits and bobs when needed.

4 Dual purpose

A tall mirror on the door dispenses a double hit of the dynamic green that characterises the shower area. The floating vanity reveals the floor tiles below to increase the feeling of space, while the gap separating the twin sets of drawers stops the unit from looking too bulky. A chunky length of snowy-white CaesarStone links the pair of drawers, giving the appearance of one unit while providing extra bench space between the basins.



DESIGN FILE

Expect to pay: \$12,500 excluding installation.

Basins: Liano inset basins, Caroma.

Cabinets: Custom Navlam laminate in Arcadian Oak, New Age Veneers.

Shower: Colour-backed glass splashback in Dulux Delta Break. Grohe Relexa Trio overhead shower, Argent Australia.

Tapware: Scala square hob sink set, Reece.

Tiles: White Satin rectified porcelain tiles (100mm x 600mm) on walls;

Cendre Lux Finish porcelain tiles (600mm x 1200mm) on floor, both Signorino Tile Gallery.

Toilet: Catalano concealed cistern toilet, Rogerseller.

Vanity: 2-pac polyurethane finish units; CaesarStone in Snow benchtop.
